The Workers Compensation Amendment Act now requires employers, workers and others affected to comply with its requirements. These requirements help create a working environment that protects and promotes the health, safety, and well being of workers. Compliance with these requirements provides a basis on which workers and employers can, in cooperation, solve workplace health and safety problems. Non-compliance of this Act will result in fines. Responsibilities Of Joint Health And Safety Committees

Includes use of OH&S Regulation, Joint H&S Committees/Worker Representatives, OH&S Program, safety inspections, accident investigations and reports, refusal of unsafe work, and musculoskeletal disorder prevention.
